REQUIREMENTS TO MANUSCRIPTS' FORMATION IN THE COLLECTIVE MONOGRAPH :

1. Materials are accepted in English
2. Page Parameters: the left, right, upper and lower field – 20 mm.
3. Paper format – A4, the type - Times New Roman (point - 12, interval - 1,0). The article's amount – from 10 to 15 pages (not less than 20000 signs), for the reviewing articles – 15-20 pages.
4. Indentation – 1,2 mm, the text lining up, according to the page width.
5. Numeration of pages – only by the pencil in the upper right corner of the page (in electronic variant the article pages are **not numerated!**).
6. Tables, graphics, drawings, photographs, diagrams should be named, are numerated and presented, according to the text of the article with the references to them. The illustrations' format shouldn't exceed the sizes of A4 sheet. The formulas should be made with the help of the editor of formulas.
7. References are formed, according to the alphabetic order (they are marked by figures in the square brackets) and are presented at the end of the article. It's necessary to present the surnames of all the quoted articles' authors in literature sources without any reduction of their list, the full name of the article, the generally accepted abbreviated name of the time description, volume, number and pages. The names of books (monographs, collections of works), dissertations, auto-reports and patents, ect. should be fully presented. It's prohibited to refer to the unpublished materials.

The authors are fully responsible for the correctness of the presented references.

References should be presented by two separate blocks :

Block 1 (Literature) – the literature list in the original language.

Bibliographic list (not less than 10 positions with the obligatory references in the text) is formed according to the DSTU 8302:2015 standard "Information and Documentation. Bibliographic Reference. General Requirements and Formation Rules" (lib.pu.if.ua/files/dstu-8302-2015.pdf).

Block 2 (References) – the analogic list of literature in English.

The correct description of the used sources in the lists of literature is the guarantee of the fact that the quoted publication will be taken into the account during the definition of the quotation index.

The file's name should correspond to the name and surname of the collective monograph article's participant (for example, P.Petrenko.docx). The article should be typed on the computer (editor - Microsoft Word 2007 or the later versions with the docx widening).

Order of Manuscripts' Location in the Collective Monograph:

The Name of the Article (in English)

Initials and surname (s) of the

The Review (in English: the author(s)' surname(s), the article name, the review text, - from 1000 to 1500 signs with the quadrats).

Key Words (up to 10 words).

The following parts are foreseen for the reviewing articles:

Problem's Formation, Investigation Purpose, Main Material's Presentation, Conclusions, References (Literature).

The following parts are foreseen for the articles of experimental character:

Introduction, Research Purpose, Material and Methods of Investigations, Investigation Results and their Discussion, Conclusions, Literature (References).

TEXT FORMATION:

All the conditional symbols and also the letters of the Greek and other alphabets should be typed expressively by the corresponding signs or should be written manually.

The figures and the text tables should be numerated by the Arabian numbers, in the order of the first mention and should be written briefly: fig.1 and tab.1 and others. If there is one drawing (figure) or one table in the text, then, it is indicated in the text: a table, a figure. The References are presented in the quadrat brackets, according to the numbers in the literature list and in accordance with Block 1.

Manuscripts won't be taken for the examination in case of their deviation from the mentioned requirements. The articles, not corresponding to the collective monograph's subject problems, will be rejected.
